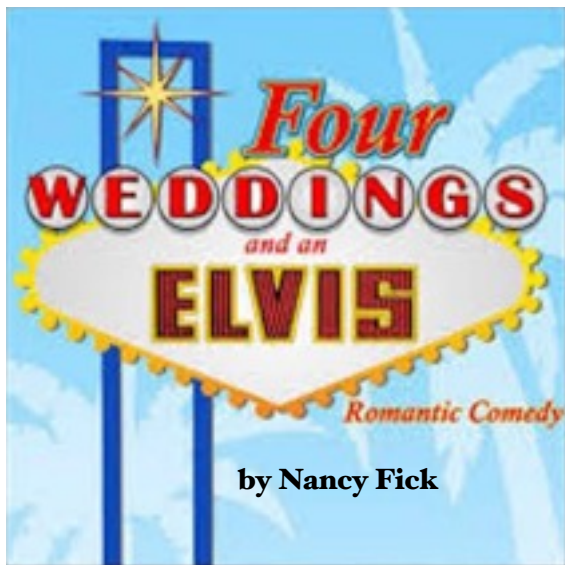

Second Wednesday is on Third Wednesday this month

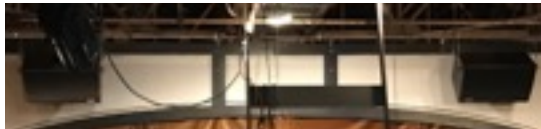
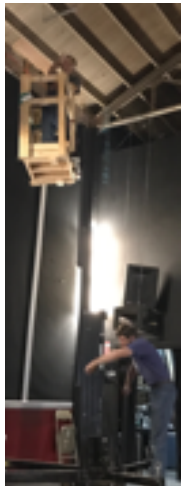
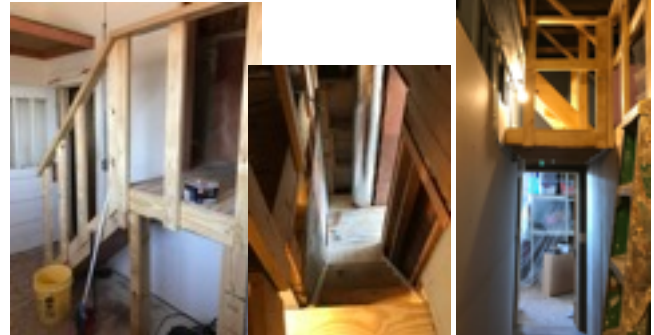

MEMBERSHIP GOES ON-LINE

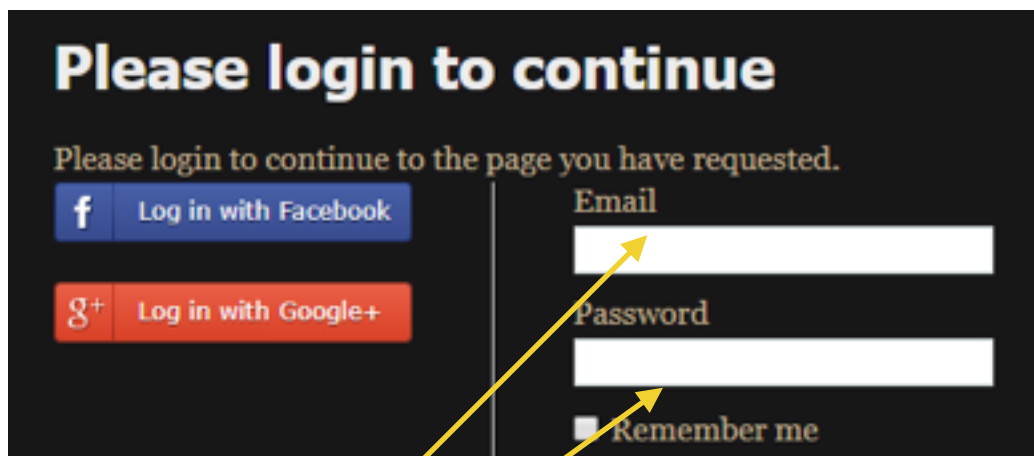

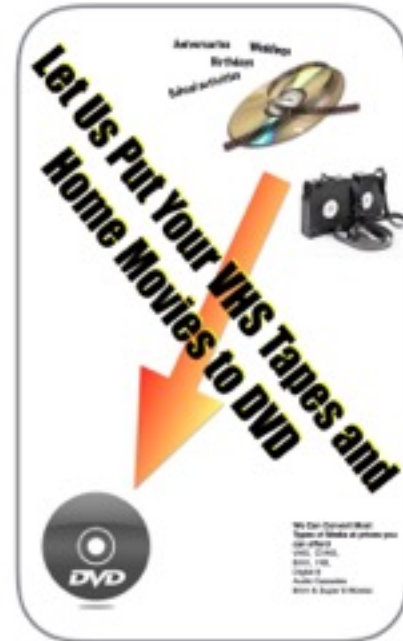
