Carver Charitable Foundation Donates \$10,000 to OLT

The Carver Foundation has been supporting the efforts of the OLT for three years now. Through the generous support of the foundation OLT has been able to install a new stage lighting system and remodel the upstairs for better storage and better use of space. A Lobby renovation will be the third in the projects it has supported.

Fund raising for the theatre lobby concession area remodel got a big boost this December. Not only the funds provided by the Carver Foundation grant but also the original benefit show, "Saturday Night Live in Mena," contributed to the assurance of the project's success. At the last meeting the OLT Board voted to embark on the project to renovate the lobby. Planned changes include are a new floor and a more organized and cleaner looking concession area. The lobby will get a more 1920's Art-Deco look using color, lighting, and furniture. The board is following the recommendations of a consultant from the Main Street Mena Project. A multi phase program to get all the work done is being developed. The first of the building phases will focus on fixing the floor, in the meantime, OLT will continue to sponsor numerous fund raising projects.



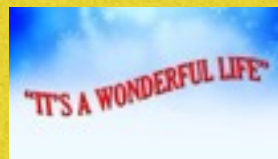

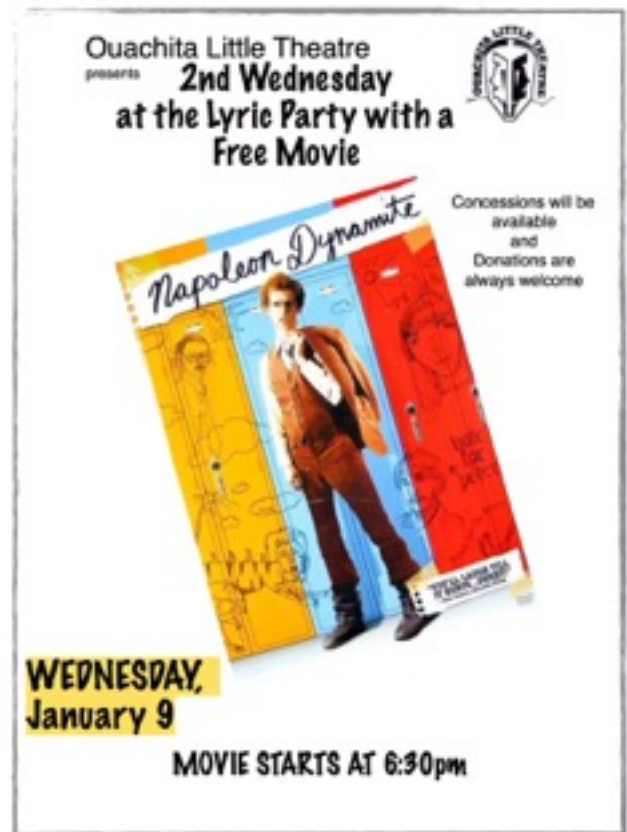
